JOB SUMMARY

The Rejoice Worship Leader is responsible for leading a team providing dynamic music at the Sunday contemporary worship service at the Rosemount campus of The Well.

- 10:30 am Sunday worship (2 hrs/week)

SPIRITUAL REQUIREMENTS

- Profess Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior
- Full engagement in active Christian lifestyle and discipline, including weekly worship attendance, small group participation, lifestyle of tithing and generosity and serving out of call and giftedness
- Commitment to personal spiritual growth and healthy lifestyle
- Models standards and expectations of Christian leadership, including positivity, professionalism and confidentiality

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Fulfill expectations stated in the Job Summary
- Be a leader for, in full alignment with, and support the purpose and core values of The Well
- Select music for worship. Coordinate selections with the liturgical calendar, The Well's calendar and pastor's sermon themes.
- As requested by the pastors, help prepare for and take part in special services such as Christmas Eve, Ash Wednesday, Holy Week, etc.
- Plan and lead Rosemount worship rehearsals
- Recruit team members
- Create a sense of community/support within the team by guiding each member and the team as a whole using the small group ministry format.
- Set personal and team goals based on The Well's thematic goal of "Connecting 100 new people to Jesus."
- Understand and adhere to Safe Sanctuary policies

- Prior experience as a worship leader and musician or regular participation as part of a worship team is desirable
- Keyboard, instrumental or guitar proficiency required
- Music degree desirable.
- Experience in teaching and developing musicians individually and as a group
