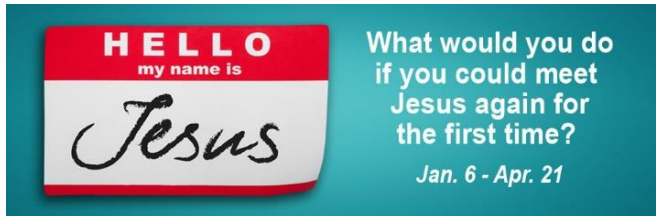

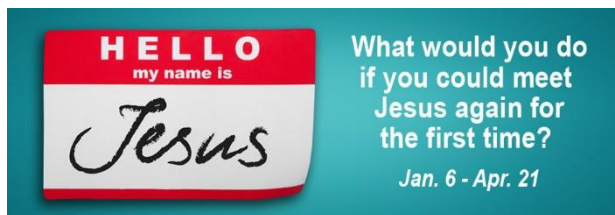
In January we're on the road for ONE THING!!
